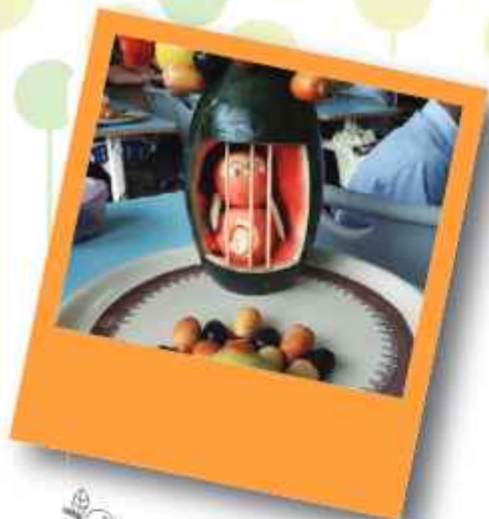

Special Assembly - Safety on School Playground

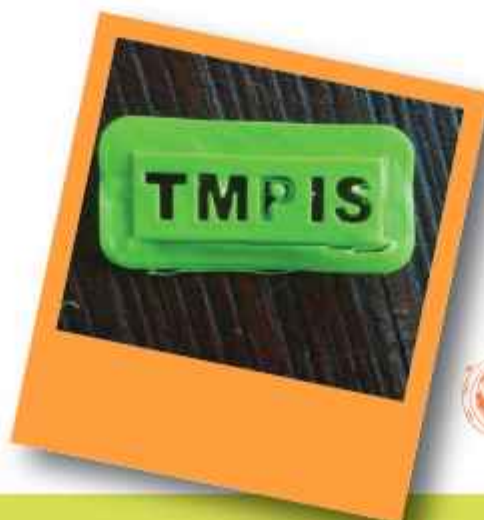
A special assembly on 'Safety on School Playground' was conducted on 10th July 2019 wherein the students of grade III A, explained safety rules to be followed on the school playground through a role play. Students were instructed not to push and pull, run about or misbehave on the playground. They were also informed about importance of discipline while playing any sport and how taking turns will make it easy for everyone to get a fair chance to play in a team. Students enjoyed learning about safety in a fun and very comprehensive way.

3D Printer Activity at Innovation Lab

The thing that makes possible to transfer our Imagination into an object is called a 3D printer and after the invention of the 3D printer that revolutionary change has happened in the real world. As the name suggests, 3D printer works on three dimensions whereas other printers work on two dimensions and the dimensions are X- horizontal axis, Y- Vertical axis, and Z- incline axis.

A 3D Printer Activity was conducted at the Innovation Academy Lab on 10th July, 2019 for the students of Grade V. Students. To initiate 3D printing first a design must be made so the students were given a word- Welcome to print at initial stage. They also learned how to print Character Blocks - TMPIS. The entire process was explained to the students that 3D printing is done using the online platform Thinker Cad and the design is transferred into the design making software such as Ultimate CURA and from that we get a file and that is stored into the storage device. This device mounts into the 3D printer and finally after this process printer is ready to create the design.

Apart from that students also learned that In 3D printer, there are two stepper motors mounted with rubber strap and with the use of that strap the motor moves and accordingly the pointer changes the position A heater is mounted on the pointer to melt the filament. The material which is used for printing is called a filament which is made up of low melting point fibre.
