

PROGRAMMES AT SCHOOL

WORLD HEALTH DAY – 7TH APRIL 2017 - With the commencement of new academic year 2017-18 the first special assembly was conducted by the students of grade- VI on account of WORLD HEALTH DAY which is celebrated every year on 7th April, the founding day of WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION (WHO).

The Health and Safety Coordinator, Ms. Priyanka Rani took up an interactive session with students and teachers on healthy living and oriented all on some tips to be healthy, followed by the Laughter Therapy session as the theme of this year's World Health Day is 'Depression'.

GO GREEN MARCH – 26TH APRIL 2017 - In a display of its commitment towards protecting the environment, T.M. PATEL INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL conducted a Go Green March on APRIL 26th 2017, which witnessed participation of all the students, teachers and blue collar employees.
